

Location Map


Exodus Residence is located at 819 Second Avenue South in downtown Minneapolis. Run by Catholic Charities, Exodus provides transitional housing for people recently discharged from the hospital. During their stay, residents receive both medical care and housing assistance from in-house nursing and care management staff. Length of resident stays range from a few months to a few years, depending on when more permanent housing is secured. While at Exodus, residents routinely pay rent and receive mail.

Most of these resident services are currently located on the first floor. This includes both the initial intake process, as well as any ongoing treatment and advocacy. Location and spatial configuration makes providing these services challenging for the staff and for the residents. For example, the area near the front door and desk is often congested while private consultation space is limited, resulting in compromised privacy if not health care confidentiality. Other spaces, including the library on the second floor, go under used. Upon in-take, residents are required to shuttle back and forth between spaces when their mobility may be compromised. The need to rid their clothes and possession of potential bedbugs requires designated space.








































