MINNESOTA LICENSE RENEWALS ARE DUE JUNE 30, 2018

Attend the A'17 MN Conference on Architecture to get the credits you need for your AIA and State of Minnesota licensing requirements. All credits listed are pending approval. According to our review, Conference programs marked as HSW and the two programs marked for ethics (T1 and TH35) will be accepted for Minnesota's CE requirement for licensing - due June 30, 2018. Additionally, plan to attend the GBCI credit programs to maintain your LEED accreditation (W24, W26, W27, W30, TH41, F59, F64).

MINNESOTA DESIGN TEAM (MDT)

WHAT IS YOUR DESIGN STORY?

As we work to transform our committee, we've reached out to architects who have been a part of the "team" over the last thirty-five years and asked them to share their stories.

In the fall of 2007 significant flooding along the Root River in SE Minnesota caused extensive damage and destruction to properties in and around Rushford. Shortly after the flood, the Minnesota Design Team "fielded" an emergency team of architects and planners to visit Rushford and make recommendations for the community's recovery.

The public school in town was not destroyed by the flood, but experienced water damage in the lower levels. Over the next couple of years, the oldest part of school, the 1906 stone building, started to settle, causing gaps between the flooring and the foundation while the and third story experienced falling ceilings. One of the recommendations from the Design Team was to rebuild the school in a new location. Susan Hart, one of the local leaders and hosts for the visit, takes up the story »


